Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

Alexander Stratis appeared on behalf of the Respondent, Decav Transport Corp., and Petitioner, DEP did not appear at a remote hearing held on 37/1/2026.

Respondent was charged with idling a truck for more than three (3) minutes at 159 W 27th Street, Manhattan in violation of AC 24-163. The violation is cited as a second violation found in Summons # 000822491Y and third violation as found in Summons # 000713371R.

AC 24-163 provides that:

No person shall cause or permit the engine of a motor vehicle, other than a legally authorized emergency motor vehicle, to idle longer than three minutes...unless the engine is used to operate a loading, unloading or processing device.

Mr. Stratis did not challenge the prior violations and denied the current violation.

I credit Petitioner's sworn statement and find it establishes a violation of the cited section of law and a second and third violation. I find that Respondent did not establish a defense or rebuttal to the charge.

Accordingly, I find Respondent in violation of the cited section of law and impose the mandatory penalty for a third violation.
