Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

On 6/10/24 , Respondent Ace Travel Inc. was issued a summons alleging a third violation of AC section 24-163 in that the citizen complainant observed Respondent's truck with Nc license plate #LA29946 idlign at a terminal point for more than three minutes at the above indicated place of occurrence.

On 6/8/26, the hearing was conducted by telephone. Respondent appeared by its authorized representative Ilma Babu . Petitioner DEP appeared by representative Michael Grosso.

Mr. Grosso rested on the summons.

Ms.Babu said that Respondent is not contesting the prior summonses referenced. She denied the charge but submitted no evidence in rebuttal.

I credit the allegations contained in the summons and find that Petitioner established a prima facie case for a third idling violation. I do not credit Respondent's denial and find that Respondent failed to submit any evidence in rebuttal. Accordingly, I sustain the summons and impose the mandatory third violation penalty.
