

The hearing was conducted by phone on July 8, 2026. Petitioner appeared through Senior Insp. Ed Sferrazza. Respondent appeared through Tiffany Irizarry, registered representative.

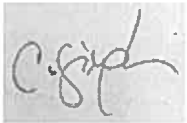
Respondent received four summonses: each except 32Z charged a repeat violation of AC 24-163 with 02H citing two prior summonses, 71Z one prior summons and 98L one prior. Summons 32Z charged the violation as a first offense.

Insp. Sferrazza stood on the summonses.

Ms. Irizarry denied the summonses with no rebuttal. She did not contest the cited priors.

I credit the IO, establishing the prima facie case for violation on each summons. I do not credit Respondent's general denial. I find the cited priors valid.

Therefore I find the Respondent in violation and impose the standard penalty on a first offense on 32Z, the standard on a second offense on 71Z and 98L, and the standard on a third or subsequent offense on 02H.
