Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

The hearing was conducted by phone on July 8, 2026. Petitioner appeared through Senior Insp. Ed Sferrazza. Respondent appeared through Tiffany Irizarry, registered representative.

Respondent was charged with a violation of AC 24-163.

Insp. Sferrazza submitted Petitioner's evidence, including a video, into the record. See Pet. Ex. 1.

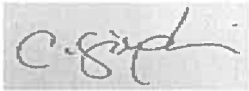
Ms. Irizarry noted that there were individuals opening or closing compartments, accessing or using a hose, and generally

working on and around the truck throughout the video.

Insp. Sferrazza argued that the work was manual and there was no processing device in use.

I credit the IO, establishing the prima facie case for violation. I credit Petitioner's evidence. I credit Ms. Irizarry's observation that folks are visibly working around and off the cited vehicle but I do not find a processing device to have been in use or any meritorious defense established.

Therefore I find Respondent in violation and impose the standard penalty.
