Findings of Facts & Conclusions of Law

Petitioner appeared by Inspector Smith. The respondent appeared by T. Irrizary from The Nacmias Law Firm.

0009-978-58X-This summons charges a third offense for violation of NYC AC 24-163, for idling of motor vehicle for longer than three minutes, first offense. Truck IN License Plate 3621136. Inspector Smith noted the record shows prior summons 0008-817-37P, was issued on 9.5.2024 and at a hearing admitted, and the penalty was paid, summons 0009032-77H, was issued on 12.6.24, after a hearing and was sustained and paid for, thus this summons is properly designated as a third offense.

Respondent's representative did not challenge the repeat designation and stated the respondent denied the violation and did not have a rebuttal. I find petitioner established its case. The summons is sustained as a third offense.

0009-981-24L- This summons charges a violation of NYC AC 24-163 (f), for idling of motor vehicle for longer than one minute in a school/park zone. Truck IN License Plate 3149206, first offense. Petitioner presented an evidence package containing a redacted idling complaint, and a photo of the front of the school, as well as a video. Petitioner rested on the contents of the summons and the evidence (P. Evidence).

Ms. Irrizary moved for a dismissal arguing the video shows the driver was inside the vehicle the entire time and most likely was checking GPS, for his next stop. Petitioner stated this is not a defense for idling in a school zone, as the respondent would have to show the vehicle had a processing unit, warranting the engine to idle. If the driver was checking GPS the engine needs to be turned off. I find the petitioner established this charge. The summons is sustained.

0009-980-06K- This summons charges a violation of NYC AC 24-163, for idling of motor vehicle for longer than three minutes, first offense. Truck PA License Plate ZNY2337. Petitioner did not appear. Respondent's representative stated the respondent denied the violation and did not have a rebuttal. I find petitioner established its case. The summons is sustained.
