Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

A hearing was held on 7-16-26 by telephone. Respondent's representative Tiffany Irizarry appeared. Petitioner was notified of the hearing via email however they waived their appearance as all their representatives were engaged and unavailable.

Respondent was charged with Idling as a first offense after respondent caused or allowed a truck to Idle with its engine for longer than three minutes.

Respondent indicated that they had already viewed the evidence and would not be contesting the factual allegation. Respondent admitted to the violation and entered a denial no rebuttal.

Petitioner was notified via email of the respondent's intention to enter a denial no rebuttal and indicated that they would be resting on the summons and their appearance would be waived. No further evidence was submitted.

I credit the sworn allegation in the summons and note respondent did not contest the facts. The summons is sustained.
