Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

The NYC Department of Environmental Protection was not present. Registered representative TIFFANY IRIZARRY appeared at a telephone hearing on July 29, 2026, on behalf of Respondent CABLEVISION SYSTEMS NEW YORK CITY CORP. Respondent's representative waived the use of an interpreter, the assistance of counsel, a formal reading of the charges and the presence of the Issuing Officer.

The summons alleges a violation of NYC Administrative Code 24-163: idling motor vehicle engine for more than 3 minutes. Date of occurrence was 01/22/25. This is a first offense.

Respondent denied the allegations and offered no rebuttal. No additional evidence was submitted.

I credit the sworn statement of the issuing officer and find that Petitioner established a violation. Respondent failed to rebut the allegations and present a valid legal defense.

Therefore, the summons is sustained, and the standard penalty is imposed.
