Findings of Facts & Conclusions of Law

A hearing was conducted by telephone on August 18, 2026. Tiffany Irizarry appeared for the respondent. Inspector Antwan Gibbs appeared for the petitioner. The summonses each alleged a violation of NY Admin. Code sec. 24-163(f) in that the respondent's truck was idling while parked or standing next to a park for over one minute.

The petitioner presented an evidence packet for each violation that included video footage of the respondent's truck idling for over one minute while parked or standing next to a park.

The respondent submitted an affidavit from the respondent stating that in each cited violation, the respondent's truck needed to idle so that its drivers could see which packaging was required for its bread orders. The respondent's reason is not an accepted exemption. I, therefore, credit the allegations in the summonses, uphold all six summonses, and impose a penalty of \$350 for each violation.
