Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

A hearing was held by telephone on 8-17-26. The Respondent appeared by attorney Micahel Sargo. The Petitioner did not appear. Respondent was charged with possession of an open alcoholic beverage a 12 oz Modelo.

Respondent attorney moved to dismiss for defective service as the affidavit of service is blank. For the reasons stated in NYPD v. Ajaz B. Kiani, Appeal No. 1801238 (June 18, 2020), I find Petitioner failed to establish proper service where the purported proof of service on the reverse side of the summons was left blank and not signed and Petitioner did not appear at the hearing to supplement its proof of service.

Petitioner's representative relied on the summons for Petitioner's main case.

Respondent's counsel denied the existence of the violating condition but did not produce any evidence or assert any affirmative defenses to the charges in the summons. Respondent's counsel did not deny the existence of the prior violations.

I find on the Petitioner's credible case that the violating conditions described in the summons existed and the standard penalty for a repeat violation is imposed.

The summons is sustained.
