Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

Respondent, charged with fire code violations, was represented by Ms. Nora Brown, Esq. The FDNY was represented by Mr. David Lopez, Esq.

Ms. Brown indicated that she was submitting evidence in this matter (Respondent's Exhibits).

Mr. Lopez examined the evidence, and recommended mitigation for all three violations.

Ms. Brown accepted the recommendation regarding VC 14 and sought dismissal of the VC 30 and VC 17 in that the plans were in existence.

Mr. Lopez stated that as far as the VC 30, the plans were requested but not produced, which is the violation.

As far as the VC 30 is concerned, the FDNY requested an F89 not an F80. The Dept needed info on a life safety director.

I find the respondent in violation and liable to the penalties for mitigation.
