Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

Petitioner, NYC Fire Department, appeared by authorized representative, Russell Walker; Respondent, appeared by authorized representative, Nora Brown.

The summons sets forth a violation of 3 RCNY 109-02, and cited violating categories ("VC"), # 1, VC # 12 and VC # 17.

Mr. Walker stated that he would rely on the allegations as set forth in the summons. He recommended a mitigated penalty for VC # 1, as the records indicated timely correction and the standard penalties for VC # 12 and VC # 17 be imposed, as there was no evidence of timely correction.

Ms. Brown argued that a mitigated penalty be imposed for VC # 1 due to timely correction.

I find that the summons sets forth a prima facie case. I find that the evidence established that VC # 1 was corrected in a timely manner for purposes of mitigation and that the standard penalties for VC # 12 and VC # 17, be imposed.

Accordingly, the summons is sustained and that the mitigated penalty for VC # 1 be imposed and that the standard the standard penalties for VC # 12 and VC # 17, be imposed.
