Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

Respondent received an NYPD summons for a violation of Section 19-190(B) of the NYC Administrative Code. In the summons, the issuing officer (IO) stated that on April 29, 2026, he was informed by Jennifer Poltorak that she was crossing from the S/E/C to the N/E/C of Bell Blvd and 56th ave in the crosswalk when she was struck by motorist sustaining injury.

In a phone in hearing, Mr. Michael Nacmias, attorney for respondent, appeared. He made a motion to dismiss on procedural grounds in that the affidavit of service is blank. He also stated that the summons does not state certain elements required of the violation, including that the respondent was in a motor vehicle and that does not specify what physical injuries were sustained by the victim.

Here, I find that service is defective in that the affidavit of service is blank. As such, I dismiss the violaton.
