Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

The hearing was conducted by telephone on 6/16/26. Attorney Michael Nacmias appeared on behalf of Respondent appeared on behalf of Respondent and there was no appearance on behalf of petitioner.

Respondent argues that the summons cannot establish a prima facie case as the affidavit of service is blank.

48 RCNY 6-08(a) requires that the petitioner file an original or copy of the summons, together with proof of service, with the Tribunal prior to the first scheduled hearing date.

The affidavit of service submitted to the tribunal is blank. It has been held that "Even if the summons is personally served, the affidavit of service should be completed to effectuate service." See NYC v. M&G General Construction, Appeal No. 1200063(May 31, 2012).

For the reasons stated above I find the requirements of 48 RCNY 6-08 have not been met.
