Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

The hearing was conducted via telephone conference call on May 20, 2026.

Michael Nacmias, attorney for Respondent, appeared at the hearing. No appearance on behalf of petitioner NYPD.

The summons charges AC 19-190(B) for failure to yield causing serious injury. Respondent's representative motioned to dismiss for no jurisdiction as the affidavit of service was blank, for failure to establish a prima facie case as the summons does not allege who had the right of way nor any serious injuries. Finally respondent's representative argued that the code section was not checked off.

According to 48 RCNY 6-08(a)(1), the petitioner must file an original or a copy of the summons, together with proof of service, with the Tribunal prior to the first scheduled hearing date. Electronic filing of the summons and proof of service is required unless the Tribunal grants an exception. Failure to timely file all proofs of service shall not divest the Tribunal of jurisdiction to proceed with a hearing or to issue a default order. This summons is dismissed for no jurisdiction since a blank affidavit of service was filed with the summons.
