Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

On 5/1/26, Respondent Janneth Cancel was issued a summons alleging a violation of AC section 19-190. The IO noted : "At TPO deft. failed to yield to ped."

On 8/5/26, the hearing was conducted by telephone. Respondent appeared by its attorney Michael Salgo. No appearance by Petitioner the Police Department.

Mr. Salgo denied the charge and moved to dismiss the summons on several grounds. He noted that the affidavit of service is blank and moved to dismiss for defective service. On the merits, he argued that the summons does not establish a prima facie

case under the cited section of law in that there is no allegation that the pedestrian had the right of way or that Respondent's vehicle made contact with the pedestrian and/or caused any injury. He said these all are all essential elements to the charge.

I grant Respondent's motion in its entirety, together or in the alternative. Summons dismissed.
