Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

Petitioner, NYPD, did not appear. Respondent, Steven Winfield, appeared by Michael Nacmias. The first hearing date was scheduled for May 26, 2026, today's hearing date. This summons is dismissed.

Respondent is charged under NYC Administrative Code Section 19-190(b) in that Respondent was driving on 6th Avenue, Respondent did not see pedestrian crossing the crosswalk, that Respondent caused a collision, that pedestrian was removed to hospital.

Respondent claimed that the summons does not state that Respondent's vehicle hit the pedestrian and challenged service. I

credit Respondent's argument. I find that the summons does not state whether Respondent's vehicle hit the pedestrian. I find that service was not proper because the affidavit of service is blank. This summons is dismissed.
