Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

Respondent's authorized representative, Ilma Babu, appeared by telephone to answer the charge of § 20-04(d) of Title 15 of the Rules of the City of New York. In the summons, the issuing officer (IO) alleged that, Respondent failed to install a backflow presentation devices or submit initial test report to DEP. The summons was issued on November 19, 2025. Petitioner, the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP), appeared by Georgie Lellman.

Petitioner's representative rested on the summons and recommended the standard \$700 penalty.

Respondent's representative testified Respondent had evidence of test repair and submitted a document titled, Form for Report

on Test and Maintenance of Containment Backflow Prevention Assembly, in support.

Petitioner's representative explained DEP needed a test report for the Wilkins-350 device, and the approval number on the document Respondent's representative submitted is not current and was the approval number for a previous device, which was the reason DEP did not accept it.

Respondent's representative argued it was a mistake on the engineer's part, not Respondent's part, to put the wrong approval number.

I credit the IO's statements on the summons. Respondent's representative's testimony and evidence did not refute the charge or establish a defense.

Accordingly, the summons is sustained.
