Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

Respondent, Heavy Duty Lifting LLC, is charged with violating NYC Administrative Code Section 24-163, Idling of motor vehicle engine for more than 3 minutes – 1st offense, for a Truck with NY License Plate # 24185PF observed on August 9, 2023, from 8:12 a.m. to 8:15 a.m., at 243 Front Street, in Brooklyn, New York.

Section 24-163 states that “No person shall or permit the engine of a motor vehicle...to idle for longer than three minutes...” Section 24-163 (f) provides for exceptions when the engine is used to operate a processing device, for mechanical work, or to maintain appropriate temperature for passenger comfort.

At the hearing, John McLaughlin represented Petitioner, NYC Department of Environmental Protection. Michael Sargo, Esq., represented the Respondent, Heavy Duty Lifting LLC.

Petitioner relied upon the sworn statement of the Issuing Officer contained in the summons. Mr. Sargo stated that he had reviewed Petitioner's evidence provided to him before the hearing. Respondent denies the violation and offers no rebuttal evidence or defense.

I find that Petitioner's evidence established the violation of the cited Code and Respondent did not present any evidence or defense.

Accordingly, this summons is Sustained.
