Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

Petitioner, NYPD, did not appear.

Respondent appeared by Michael Nacmias, Esq. - Nacmias Law Firm.

The hearing was held on November 20, 2025, via CourtCall.

0200063977 Jacob Friedman-Respondent was charged with one count of 19-190 - Failure to Yield, in that at time of offense, Respondent struck pedestrian in the crosswalk.

Respondent made a motion to dismiss and states that the affidavit of service is defective and relied on Appeal No. 1801238 NYPD v. Ajaz B. Kiani June 18, 2020, arguing that the affidavit of service is unsigned and requires dismissal. Respondent also argued that the violation fails to state that the Respondent was in a motor vehicle and the injury was not detailed or specific.

I agree with Respondent's attorney and find that the affidavit of service is not dated, signed or sworn to by the issuing officer. I also agree that the violation fails to state that the Respondent was in a motor vehicle.

Therefore, the violation is dismissed.
