Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

This hearing was conducted remotely by telephone. Petitioner, was not present for this hearing. Respondent appeared by Michael Nacmias, Esq. Respondent is charged with violating section 16-118(6) of New York City Administrative Code.

Mr. Nacmias moved to dismiss based upon the fact that the affidavit of service was not signed.

In *NYPD v. Ajaz B. Kiani*, Appeal No. 1801238 (June 18, 2020), that upon Respondent's challenge to service, Petitioner failed to establish proper service where the purported proof of service on the reverse side of the summons was left blank and not signed and Petitioner did not appear at the hearing to supplement its proof of service. Accordingly, the summons is defective.
