Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

Respondent was charged with with a violation of Code 16-118(b). The Respondent's attorney Michael Nacmias appeared. The Petitioner did not appear. Respondent's attorney waived the right to an interpreter and to the issuing officer/inspector.

Mr. Nacmias argued that the affidavit of service is blank and therefore the summons should be dismissed. Mr. Nacmias further argued that the summons does not establish a prima facie case as it is not clear that the Respondent is the one urinating.

I find that the summons does not establish a prima facie case as it is unclear that the Respondent is the one committing a

violation. Moreover, the affidavit of service is blank. Petitioner failed to establish proper service where the purported proof of service on the reverse side of the summons was left blank and not signed and Petitioner did not appear at the hearing to supplement its proof of service. Accordingly, the summons is defective on its face and it is dismissed.
