Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

On November 29, 2023, at 5:30 p.m., a summons was issued to Respondent, SAT Construction Service LLC, for violating NYC Administrative Code Section 24-220(c), for failure to have keep/have available for inspection a copy of Noise Mitigation Plan- 1st offense, at the premises located at 185 Ainslie Street, Brooklyn, New York. The Issuing Officer noted that the plan shall be displayed in a conspicuous manner on the exterior of the premises and the site was closed.

Code § 24-220(c) provides: A copy of the plan shall be kept at the construction site and shall be displayed in a conspicuous manner on the exterior of the construction site and made accessible for inspection by the public and persons authorized to enforce the provisions of this code provided that where there are no exterior structures on the construction site such plan need

only be kept at the site and made accessible for inspection by the public and persons authorized to enforce the provisions of this code.

At the hearing, Caroline Kane, Esq., represented the Respondent, SAT Construction Services LLC. Petitioner, NYC Department of Environmental Protection, waived its appearance.

Ms. Kane stated that Respondent denies the violation and offered no rebuttal evidence or defense.

I credit the testimony and evidence offered on behalf of the Respondent. I find that Petitioner established the violation of Section of 24-220(c). I also find that Respondent did not offer any evidence or defense.

Accordingly, this summons is Sustained.
