Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

Caroline Kane, Attorney for Respondent, GALICIA CONTRACTING & RES and Dallas Mahan, Attorney for Petitioner, Department of Buildings. The parties appeared for a hearing by telephone on May 23, 2025. Issuing Officer Sokolowski Badge 2985 also appeared to testify.

Respondent is charged with a Class 1 violation of Section 3301.2 of the Building Code for failure to institute/maintain safety measures. The summons states that there was accident during hoisting operations. The summons further states that the work being done was not provided with design drawings and a failure to provide adequate safety measures for scope of work created unsafe conditions.

Respondent's counsel argues that this summons is duplicative of the numerous other summonses that Respondent was issued due to this accident.

With this summons, the following summonses were issued 035447101H, 035447103L, 035447109M, 035447104N, 035447105P, 035447106R, 035447110J, and 035447100X. These summonses were issued for the exact conditions cited in this summons, including failure to safeguard and lack of design drawings for the hoisting equipment. Respondent was found in violation of all the listed summonses. The Issuing Officer fails to mention any additional failures in safeguards in this summons. Therefore, while I credit the summons, I find it duplicative. Accordingly, this summons is dismissed.
