Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

The hearing was conducted on August 5, 2025, by Court Call. Petitioner appeared through Senior Inspector Monica Dorson. Respondent, Steel Construction LLC, appeared through counsel, Michael Nacmias, Esq. of Nacmias Law.

The summons charges a violation of 24-163 of the Administrative Code in that Respondent caused or permitted the idling of a motor vehicle while parked, standing, or stopped for more than three minutes. The issuing officer states that, as per DEP records, a citizen observed a Truck with NY license plate no. STEEL3 idling for longer than three minutes from 10/11/2023 2:19:42 PM to 10/11/2023 2:22:45 PM On Tuckerton Street between Liberty Avenue and 157th Street in Queens.

Petitioner rests on the summons.

Respondent denies, but does not rebut, the allegations set forth in the summons.

I credit the issuing officer. Petitioner has, thus, established a prima facie case.

Accordingly, the Summons is sustained.
