Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

This telephone hearing was held on December 22, 2025. Petitioner, NYCDEP, appeared by Antwan Gibbs, Representative. Respondent, Northeast Interior Demolition, appeared by Ilma Babu, Authorized Representative. She waived translation services, counsel and the appearance of the Issuing Officer (IO).

This summons alleges third violation of NYC Administrative Code §24-146(b) (Dust allowed to become air-borne) The summons states that as per citizen's complaint, Respondent allowed or permitted dust to become airborne without taking precautions, causing construction materials to generate dust into the public right of way while transporting such materials into a garbage truck (LIC. NY #14599MP, in violation of 24-146(b) of the NYC air code; source of particulate emissions (dust) from

workers dumping construction materials without any mitigation allowing dust to become airborne, causing an annoyance and discomfort to pedestrians in the public right of way.

Mr. Gibbs relied on the sworn statements of the IO in the summons and he submitted 2 photos taken by the citizen when the violation was issued (P-1 & 2) The photos depict the license plate and the front of the truck which was receiving the construction materials. He also submitted a copy of the Respondent's Department of State information (P-3) and three videos depicting airborne dust caused by the failure of Respondent to take precautions when loading construction materials on to the truck. The videos could not be uploaded due to their size.

Ms. Babu did not challenge the two prior violations. After reviewing Petitioner's evidence, including the videos, she denied this violation. She did not provide any testimony or evidence to rebut this charge.

NYC Administrative Code § 24-146(b) states that" No person shall cause or permit any material that may generate dust to be transported or stored without taking such precautions as may be ordered by the commissioner or as established by the rules of the department to prevent dust from becoming air-borne"

I credit Petitioner's evidence and the IO's affirmed statements in the summons regarding Respondent's failure to take precautions to prevent dust/particulate matter from becoming airborne. Respondent did not establish any defense to this violation. I further find that Respondent is in violation of NYC Administrative Code §24-146 (b). This third violation is sustained and a penalty of \$1,200 is imposed.
