Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

MARIA DOLLAS, ESQ., appeared for the Department of Buildings (DOB), the petitioner here. PHOEBE DOSSETT, ESQ., appeared for the respondent. The summons alleges that upon inspection of respondent's property, the issuing inspector observed a temporary construction, specially a sidewalk shed at exposures 1 and 2 of the property, with missing information panel, which is required. Accordingly, the inspector issued this summons as a class 2 violation of section 3301.9 of the Building Code. The summons also seeks penalty as a Recurring Condition - Aggravated I, allegedly based on the respondent's history of similar violations.

At the hearing, petitioner rested on the allegations contained within the four corners of the summons. I find that petitioner

makes a prima facie showing of the violation.

Respondent's counsel denied liability for the summons, but conceded that she possessed no additional information that can rebut petitioner's prima facie shwoing. Moreover, she conceded the respondent's prior history of similar violations so as to support the petitioner's request for penalty as a Recurring Condition - Aggravated I penalty.

In light of the foregoing, I find that respondent has failed to establish a valid defense. I find respondent in violation and I impose the applicable penalty for a Recurring Condition - Aggravated I violation.

The summons is sustained.
