Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

On February 12, 2026, a hearing was held on the instant matter. Michael Nacmias, ESQ., appeared on behalf of the Respondent and Wilda Gomez appeared on behalf of the Petitioner, NYPD. Mr. Nacmias waived the reading of the summons into the record.

Ms. Gomez provided various exhibits, which were introduced into evidence as Petitioner's Exhibits, which include the Commercial Refuse Container Permit, the instant summons, and three photographs showing the commercial refuse container outside of the cited premise. Mr. Nacmias provided a permit, which was introduced as a Respondent's Exhibit, which shows that a permit was issued on 4/3/2025 (and specifically states valid from 4/7 through 4/11).

Here, I credit the issuing officer's observations. Indeed, Mr. Nacmias' evidence shows that the permit was not valid when the issuing officer made their observation on April 1, 2025. As such, the summons is sustained and a fine of \$750 is imposed.
