Findings of Facts & Conclusions of Law

The sworn-to-summons alleges a violation of § 24-163 of the Administrative Code (Code) for idling of motor vehicle engine more than three minutes – 2nd offense.

Authorized representative, Alfred Lin, for Respondent, Twenty-Four 7 Contracting Corp., was present. Petitioner, Department of Environmental Protection (DEP), did not appear. Respondent's representative waived the right to have an attorney present.

Respondent's representative denied the allegations with no rebuttal.

I credit the sworn-to-summons. I find that the summons as alleged is legally sufficient to establish the violation charged. I find that the Respondent did not present a valid legal defense. Respondent failed to provide credible evidence to rebut the allegations. Accordingly, the summons is sustained, and a \$440.00 violation penalty is imposed.
