Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

The hearing was held via telephone on 7/21/2025. The respondent appeared by authorized representative, Mr. Joshua Santis. Ms. Dantney Parks appeared for the petitioner.

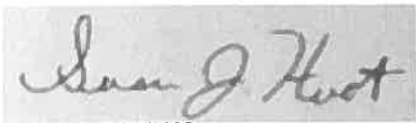
The summons alleges a 2nd offense violation of AC 24-163 for idling a truck with NY License Plate # 83066MJ longer than three minutes on Albee Square between Fulton Street and Willoughby Street in Brooklyn. It cites prior summons number 000764023K.

Mr. Santis did not contest the validity of the cited prior summons. He stated that while the respondent generally denies the

present violation, he will present no evidence or argument in rebuttal.

I credit the sworn statements in the summons and find the petitioner has established a valid charge. Given Mr. Santis' statement, I find the respondent has not rebutted the charge by a preponderance of credible evidence.

I sustain the summons and assess the \$440 2nd offense penalty.
