Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

Andre Autz, Esq. , the authorized hearing representative of the Respondent HELLMAN ELECTRIC LLC appeared at today's hearing.

Inspector Ahmad appeared on behalf of the Petitioner the Police Department.

The Respondent is charged with failing to maintain a clear pedestrian path at the cited location pursuant to AC 19-102(ii).

Mr. Ahmad submitted identifying permit details and photographs made a part of this file. He noted no concrete curing was

taking place at the time of this occurrence.

Mr. Autz argued there was concrete curing taking place. He argued the barrels are on top of the concrete being cured. He submitted photographs depicting the barrels.

Mr. Autz could offer no evidence as to when the concrete was poured.

I credit the sworn observations of the issuing officer.

Mr. Autz argued this summons is duplicative to summons #218237288 as the location is at the same corner.

Inspector Ahmad noted there are two permits, with two different descriptions of the work being performed.

I find these summonses are not duplicative as the location at issue herein has a different permit than the location cited on summons # 218237288.

Accordingly, I credit the Petitioner, find the Respondent in violation, and impose the statutory penalty.
