Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

This remote hearing was conducted on June 18, 2025. Respondent (Empire State Towing and Service Inc.) appeared by authorized representative, Lance Chebin. Senior Inspector Antwan Gibbs appeared for Petitioner (DEP).

Respondent was charged with a violation of 24-163-1st offense. Respondent caused or permitted the idling of a motor vehicle while parked, standing or stopped. As per DEP records, citizen observed TRUCK with NY license Plate # 14851TV idling for longer than three minutes from 11/18/2024 2:00:48 PM to 11/18/2024 2:04:52 PM on 65 St between 14 Ave and New Utrecht Ave.

Inspector Gibbs rested on the summons.

Mr. Chebin stated, "DNR."

Based on the record before me, I credit the issuing officer's affirmation of the factual allegations. Respondent's representative denied the violation. However, he failed to present any credible evidence to refute the factual allegations, nor did he establish any legally valid defenses. Accordingly, I sustain this summons.
