Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

Rafeena Khairullah, Esq and Inspector M. Harben (Badge No. 3687) appeared for the petitioner. Frank Tamberino, Esq. appeared for the respondent

On the date and at the location indicated on the summons, the officer observed that a construction fence was missing the required information panel. I credit these observations.

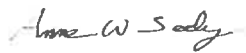
Ms. Khairullah submitted photographs and overview of the complaint (Pet). I credit this evidence.

Inspector Harben testified that the construction gate was locked and he knocked on the fence and he looked around and could not find anyone and no one responded to the knocking and he posted on the construction fence. I credit this testimony.

In response to question by Mr. Tambrino, Inspector testified that he saw no signs or permits with numbers on them to contact respondent. I credit this testimony.

Mr. Tamberino denied without rebuttal.

I find that the conditions were as described in the summons. The credited findings establish a violation of the cited code section. Accordingly, the violation is sustained, and the above fine is imposed.
