Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

Respondent BUILDERS JOSEPH AND SONS LLC appeared at a remote telephonic hearing on 2/19/2026 by Michael Sargo, Esq. of the Nacmias Law Firm.

Petitioner NYC Dept. of Transportation appeared by Insp. Keith White.

Respondent is charged with a violation of NYC Adm. Code 19-121(a) for allegedly having concrete bricks stored on the street without a Permit.

Insp. White submitted (3) photos showing concrete bricks on skids on the roadway at the location cited in the Summons and a DOB Permit. (Petitioner's Exhibits 1-4)

Mr. Sargo reviewed Petitioner's evidence. He denied the violation but presented no facts to rebut the allegations in the Summons and he presented no valid legal defense to the charge.

I credit the allegations in the Summons and find Respondent in violation.

Accordingly, the Summons is sustained, and the approved penalty is imposed.
