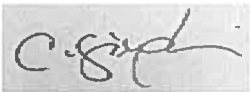
Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

The hearing was conducted by telephone on January 5, 2026. Petitioner did not appear. Respondent appeared through Michael Nacmias, Esq.

Respondent was charged with a violation of AC 19-190(b) after the IO alleged being informed by Respondent that Respondent was driving and did not see a pedestrian, therefore failing to yield.

Mr. Nacmias moved to dismiss the summons based on the blank affidavit of service. On the merits, he argued no prima facie case was established where the summons alleged no physical injury.

I dismiss the summons for defective service.
