Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

Petitioner appeared by M. Dorson. Respondent appeared by J. Santis. Petitioner charges Respondent with a violation of NYC AC 24-163(f) as a second offense. Ms. Dorson submitted evidence, prior summonses, and video to support the charge (Pet Ex 1). Mr. Santis argued that the summons had an incorrect address for Respondent and submitted a public inquiry document to support his argument (Resp Ex A). Ms. Dorson explained that DEP was not required to send the summons to the address on the truck and in this instance sent the summons to an address from a prior summons that had been paid by Respondent, and submitted evidence to establish the connection between Respondent and the address (Pet Ex 2). I credit her evidence and find a correct address was provided for the Respondent. No further defense or evidence was submitted. I credit the allegations in the summons and find Respondent was in violation on the cited date. I uphold the violation and impose the penalty for a

second violation.
