Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

A hearing was held by telephone on April 23, 2026. The Respondent's attorney Michael Nacmias appeared. The Petitioner did not appear. Respondent was charged with failure to yield injury in violation of 19-190(b). The affidavit of service is blank. The allegation in the summons stated right of way, failure to yield, physical injury.

Respondent's attorney argues that the summons is defective as the affidavit of service page is not signed. blank. He further argued that the summons cannot establish a prima facie case there is insufficient allegation made to support a physical injury as the allegation merely states physical injury which is conclusory.

For the reasons stated in NYPD v. Ajaz B. Kiani, Appeal No. 1801238 (June 18, 2020), I find Petitioner failed to establish proper service where the purported proof of service on the reverse side of the summons was left blank and not signed and Petitioner did not appear at the hearing to supplement its proof of service. Further the allegation of physical injury is conclusory and fails to establish an injury within the definition of the NYS Penal Law. Accordingly the summons is dismissed.
