Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

The NYC Department of Environmental Protection was represented by senior inspector Michael Grosso at a telephone hearing on November 6, 2024. Registered representative Lance Chebin appeared on behalf of Respondent HUGH O'KANE ELECTRIC COMPANY INC. Respondent's representative waived the use of a translator, the assistance of counsel, a formal reading of the summons and the presence of the Issuing Officer.

The summons alleges a violation of NYC Administrative Code 24-163: idling motor vehicle engine for more than 3 minutes in that a citizen observed a van with NY license plate #11889MA idling for more than three minutes on 05/03/23 from 12:33 PM - 12:37 PM at intersection of Broadway and 55th Street. This is a first offense.

Petitioner relied on the sworn narrative. No additional evidence was submitted.

Respondent's representative denied the allegations and offered no rebuttal. No additional evidence was submitted.

I credit the sworn statement of the issuing officer and Petitioner established a violation. Respondent failed to offer any rebuttal and present a valid legal defense.

Therefore, the summons is sustained, and the standard penalty is imposed as a first offense.
