Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

Michael Nacmias, Esq. appeared for Respondent. Petitioner NYPD did not appear and relied on the summons.

Respondent was cited for violating AC 19-190. The summons alleges that officer was informed by victim that driver failed to exercise due caution entering pedestrian crosswalk while bicyclist was crossing in the bicycle lane.

Mr. Nacmias challenged service. He cited Appeal No. 2000420. On the merits, he argued that the allegation does not indicate Respondent is the driver, and does not indicate physical injury. The summons does not specify subsection (a) or (b).

The certificate of service is blank (Hearing Officer Exhibit 1). I find the service was defective. The summons is dismissed.
