Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

Michael Sargo, Esq. appeared for Respondent. Petitioner NYPD did not appear and relied on the summons.

Respondent was cited for violating AC 19-190(b) for failure to yield. The summons alleges the motorist was observed failing to yield to pedestrian.

Mr. Sargo argued defective service because the affidavit of service is blank. He argued that the summons fails to establish a prima facie case as it lacks details of injury and even fails to state "injury."

I find service was defective. I also find that Petitioner did not establish a prima facie case. The allegation does not indicate the injury which is a required element of the violation. The summons is dismissed.
