Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

The hearing was conducted on December 10, 2024, by Court Call. Petitioner appeared through Inspector Leah Smith. Respondent, AP Electrical Services & Maintenance Inc, appeared through their registered representative, Lance Chebin of Nacmias Law.

The summons charges a violation of 24-163 of the Administrative Code in that Respondent caused or permitted the idling of a motor vehicle while parked, standing, or stopped for more than three minutes. The issuing officer states that, as per DEP records, a citizen observed a Truck with NJ license plate no. AU105X idling for longer than three minutes from 12/12/2023 2:40:54 PM to 12/12/2023 2:44:43 PM at 424 West 45th Street in Manhattan. This is cited as a third offense with summons

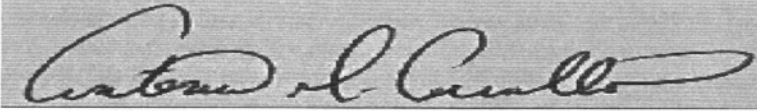
nos. 000757471Z and 000770448R cited on the face of the summons as prior violations.

Petitioner rests on the summons.

Respondent denies, but does not rebut, the allegations set forth in the summons.

I credit the evidence submitted by the Petitioner. Petitioner has established a prima facie case through the evidence presented.

Accordingly, the Summons is sustained.
