Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

This hearing was conducted remotely by telephone. Petitioner, NYPD was not present for the hearing. Respondent appeared by his attorney Michael Nacmias.

Respondent is charged with violating section 24-163 of New York City Administrative Code. Mr. Nacmias stated that the affidavit of service is not filled out and thus the service is bad. Mr. Nacmias also stated that according to AC 24-163, the summons needs to state how long the idling took place and thus the summons does not establish a prima facie case.

I find that since the affidavit of service is blank there is not proper service of the summons, and additionally the summons

does not establish a prima facie case as it does not specify how long the idling took place.

Accordingly the summons is dismissed.
