Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

Penske Truck Leasing Corporation

Lance Chebin, authorized representative appeared for the respondent. Inspector Leah Smith appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

The petitioner supplied 5 attachments; two photos identifying the license plate, a redacted civilian complaint, a plate run which

showed the respondent as owner and a video which cannot be uploaded due to technical difficulty.

The video was reviewed by all parties.

The respondent made a motion to dismiss based upon improper party due to the fact the respondent's name was not on the vehicle and the proper party to name would be Dumbo moving and storage which is the name on the truck. There was no additional testimony or evidence submitted.

The petitioner stated that the section of law "explicitly makes an owner a culpable party, regardless of whether it actually operates the business." Appeal No.000010, DEP v U-Haul Co of Arizona, 4/23/2020.

Based upon the above, I find the respondent as the owner of the vehicle is a proper party and deny the respondent's motion to dismiss. Accordingly, I find the respondent in violation of 24-163 and impose the standard penalty.
