Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

Respondent DHL EXPRESS USA INC appeared at a remote telephonic hearing on 4/8/2025 by its authorized representative Mr. Lance Chebin of the Nacmias Law Firm.

Petitioner NYC Dept. of Environmental Protection appeared by Insp. Michael Grosso.

Respondent is charged with a third violation of NYC Adm. Code 24-163 for allegedly causing or permitting the engine of the vehicle cited in the Summons to idle for more than three minutes while parked, standing, or stopped.

Mr. Chebin stated that he received Petitioner's evidence prior to the hearing. He denied the violation but presented no facts to rebut the allegations in the Summons and presented no valid legal defense to the charge. He did not deny that this was a third violation of the cited section of law.

I credit the unrefuted allegations in the Summons and find Respondent in violation.

Accordingly, the Summons is sustained, and the approved penalty for a 3rd violation of the cited section of law is imposed.
