Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

Respondent, HUGH O'KANE ELECTRIC, appeared by remote hearing. Respondent was represented by its authorized representative Nora Brown. Petitioner, Police Department was represented by Ejaz Ahmad.

The summons charges 34 RCNY 2-07(c)(4)(i)-working without an authorization number. Mr. Ahmad submitted the summons, three photographs, and the permit in support of the charge. Mr. Ahmad stated that the place of occurrence on the summons is the intersection of West 23 Street and 9 Avenue. The address on the permit is 9 Avenue between West 23 and West 24 Street.

Ms. Brown stated that the photos submitted by the Petitioner match the location details in the permit. Mr. Ahmad stated that the manhole was in the intersection, so Respondent needed to obtain a separate permit. If the manhole was on the crosswalk, another permit would not be required.

I credit the details alleged on the summons and find that Respondent was working at the intersection of West 23 and 9 Avenue without an authorization number.

Accordingly, the Summons is sustained.
