Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

This summons was issued for an alleged violation of 24-236(e) as a 1st offense; Cause or permitted sound from motor vehicle on a public row.

Petitioner submitted evidence in support of the summons including a photo of the license plate, stills from the video, photos of the vehicle and the sound camera with red dot and photos, screenshot camera location and device name, measured dba, and report view proof of service.

Inspector Smith pointed out that frame shows where the vehicle exceeds 76 db, that the camera triggers when this happens

and traces the vehicle, that there were no other vehicles at this time, and the DMV plate run is for registrant/respondent's information.

After review respondent's representative pointed out that the db were more than what it is supposed to be but not very high and requested mitigation as respondent was not aware of the rule.

I credit the summons as supported by evidence presented and find respondent did not establish a valid rebuttal or defense. That respondent was not aware of the rule or that the recorded decibels were "not that high" is not a valid legal excuse or basis for mitigation.

Sustained.
