Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

A hearing was held on July 17, 2025 via telephone in connection with summons number 000913242R ("the summons") which cites a violation of N.Y.C. Administrative Code Section 24-163. On June 28, 2024, an unidentified citizen observed the idling of a truck with N.Y.S. license plate number 65137MM for more than three minutes on Remsen Street between Henry Street and Hicks Street in Brooklyn, New York. The summons is written as a first offense violation.

The Petitioner was notified of the hearing, but waived its appearance in writing based on the notification that the Respondent

intended to deny the summons without any rebuttal.

Representative Joshua Santis appeared on behalf of the Respondent at the hearing.

The Respondent waived the reading of the summons.

The Respondent denied the cited violation charge within the summons without any rebuttal.

The summons makes out a prima facie violation of N.Y.C. Administrative Code Section 24-163. The Respondent has not established a meritorious defense to the summons. As such, the summons is hereby sustained. A standard penalty for a first offense violation of N.Y.C. Administrative Code Section 24-163 shall be imposed.
