Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

The hearing was held via telephone on 6/9/2025. The respondent appeared by authorized representative, Mr. Lance Chebin. Ms. Dantney Parks appeared for the petitioner.

The summons alleges a third/subsequent violation of AC 24-163 for idling a truck with NY License Plate # 62169PC longer than three minutes at 301 Sacket Street in Brooklyn. It cites prior summons numbers 000735395Z and 000805623M.

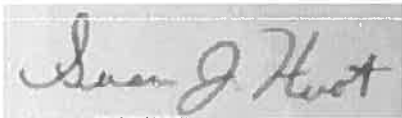
Ms. Parks relied on the sworn statements in the summons. In support of the violation, she submitted a Citizen Observation Video approximately 4:33 seconds in length, a redacted Citizen's Idling Complaint Form, two photographs of the subject

vehicle, and copies of the cited prior summonses.

Upon review of the petitioner's evidence, Mr. Chebin stated that while his client generally denies the violation, he will present no evidence or argument in rebuttal. He did not contest the validity of the cited prior summonses.

I credit the sworn statements in the summons and find the petitioner has established a valid charge. Given Mr. Chebin's statement, I find the respondent has not rebutted the charge.

I sustain the summons and assess the \$600 third/subsequent penalty.
