Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

A telephonic hearing was held on October 8, 2025.

Respondent was charged with a violation of Administrative code 24-163 in that Respondent caused or permitted the idling of a motor vehicle with NJ license plate #86817MM while parked, standing or stopped for longer than three minutes on 01/15/2025 on Livingston Street between Elm Pl and Hoyt St. This violation was listed as a second offense based on summons 000767178Z.

Petitioner was represented Andy Guzman who relied on the summons.

Respondent was represented by Nora Brown who denied the violation without presenting any rebuttal.

Here, I credit the summons and find that the same are sufficient to establish the charged violation. I find that credible contrary evidence or a valid legal defense was not presented. Accordingly, the summons is SUSTAINED.
