Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

Nora Brown the authorized representative of the Respondent RAPID ARMORED CORPORATION appeared at today's hearing.

Andy Guzman appeared for the Petitioner, the Department of Environmental Protection.

The Respondent is charged with making a false statement in that the subject vehicle had a sticker indicating it was exempt from idling regulations.

Inspector Guzman produced photographs, a complaint report, and proof of service made a part of this file.

Ms. Brown argued the Respondent had a variance in effect. She submitted a letter issued to Rapid Armour dated July 29, 2021. She argued the letter allows for the variance.

Inspector Guzman argued the variance indicated in Respondent's letter had expired prior to the issuance of this summons and was not extended or in effect when this summons was issued.

She further noted the sticker is ripped, illegible, and not in use.

The inspector was unable offer a dispute the illegible sticker.

Upon review the sticker is ripped does not appear to be in use.

As such, I credit Ms. Brown as to the depicted sticker.

Accordingly, this summons is dismissed.
