Findings of Fact & Conclusions of Law

Michael Sargo, Esq. appeared as the authorized representative of the Respondent. Petitioner did not appear.

Respondent is charged with a violation of Administrative Code 10-125 for failing to comply with the cited code requirements, as described in the summons.

Mr. Sargo moved to dismiss the summons for failure to provide proof of service. Mr. Sargo also stated that Petitioner failed to provide proof of service because the Affidavit of Service is blank. Mr. Sargo further stated that on the merits, the summons fails to state the alleged alcohol observed nor does it state what percent of alcohol was observed.

Upon the review of the summons, I find that it does not establish a prima facie case because it does not allege what kind of alcoholic beverage was observed. Therefore, I do not credit the allegations. I find that the Affidavit of Service is blank. As such, I find that Petitioner failed to provide proof of service of the summons, and the Office of Administrative Trials and Hearings lacks jurisdiction.
